 Married couple has established their home, but do not yet have kids.




Stage 2: Childbearing Family




 From birth of first child until that child is 2 1/2 yrs old.

Stage 4: Family w/ School Kids




 When the oldest child is between 6-13 yrs.




Birth Order Characteristics
