## Marriage Statistics


$\square 90 \%$ of Americans marry at some point
$\square$ Utah's marriage rate is 10.6 per 1,000 populations -United States Stands at 8.7
$\square$ Utah's divorce rate is 4.3 per 1,000 populations
$\square$ United States divorce rate stands at 4.1

## Marriage Statistics

Of the 23,896 marriages that took place in Utah in 2000
$\square 72.5 \%$ were first marriages for both bride and groom
$\square 26.5 \%$ of them were remarriages for the bride or groom
$\square$ Median age at first marriage in United States

- Groom: 26.8 Bride: 25.1
$\square$ Median age at first marriage in Utah
$\square$ Groom: 23 Bride: 21


## Marriage Statistics

## $\square$ In Utah

$\square 77 \%$ of the marriages are performed by a religious officiant
$\square 23 \%$ are performed by a civil officiant
$\square 60 \%$ of brides in first marriages have had at least one or more years of college.

- In 2000 the month of August is when the greatest amount of marriages took place
- 3074 marriages took place during this month



## Marriage Statistics


$\square$ Median age at divorce in Utah for first marriages:

- Husband: 31
- Wife: 29
$\square$ 18\% of divorces in Utah occur in the first year of marriage
$\square 50 \%$ of the divorces in Utah occur within the first 5 years of marriage and $70 \%$ by 10 years of marriage


## Marriage Statistics

## $\square$ In the United States

$\square$ After 5 years, 1 in 5 first marriages (20\%) have disrupted in either separation or divorce
$\square$ After 10 years, one-third (33\%) of first marriages have disrupted

- Seven years is the average length of $1^{\text {st }}$ marriages that end in divorce
$\square 54 \%$ of divorced women remarry within 5 years and $75 \%$ remarry within 10 years


## Why people Marry . . .

$\square$ Trapped
$\square$ Pregnancy or promises of engagement
$\square$ Escape
$\square$ Marry to get out of the house or escape
$\square$ Obligation
$\square$ Because of sexually activity or other obligation
$\square$ Status Change
$\square$ Moving, going to college, or graduating


## Why People Marry . . .


$\square$ Set Variable

- You've found the person you believe is the right person
$\square$ Pity
$\square$ Pity and love are two close emotions and some people can't distinguish between the two
$\square$ Love
- Hopefully all will include some of this emotion in their marriage
$\square$ Pressure
$\square$ Getting older and fear of not getting married


## Why People Marry. . .

$\square$ Money

- Financially I can marry now
$\square$ Family
- You're ready to have a family and want to be married before having children
